I wish to submit the following, which outlines the current seat allocation to the population ratio for the Galway City No 1 known locally as the North and East Ward.

The North and East Ward electoral area currently has(7) seats.

The population figures in the 2006 census were 35.000.

This figure represents (48%) of the population of the city.

The North and East Ward, creates a natural division through its western boundary of the river Corrib.It is an identifiable and developed electoral area.

The wards allocation of seats is almost exactly proportional to its population.

I therefore propose that the boundary should not change, nor should a division in those two wards be considered in your review.
