The undersigned propose the following changes to Ward One and Two of Limerick City

CURRENT POPULATION CSO 2006

Ward One 21,040	5 seats
Ward Two 13,787	4 seats
Ward Three 11,026	4 seats
Ward Four 14,527	4 seats

Limerick City Boundary Extension 1<sup>st</sup> March

The extension of the Cities Boundary as from the 1<sup>st</sup> March has resulted in a net population increase of 7253 which geographically now reside in electoral area Ward One

As such and in adhering to the guidelines proposed by Minister Gormley, we propose the following changes to the Local Electoral Areas of Limerick City

Transfer from Ward One the following CSO electoral blocks into Ward Two

Killeely A 1579

Killeely B 950

Ballynanty 3471

This proposed change is based on using the Cratloe Road as the boundary. We argue that this change adhere most closely to Minister Gormley's guidelines as it preserves natural communities and their hinterlands as defined in Des McCafferty's report for the Limerick City Development Board entitled 'Limerick: Profile of a Changing City' (See attached). This new boundary also provides electoral areas which have urban or neighbourhood focal points. These changes fall within the Minister's terms of reference and with the minimum of change, will produce a 5 seat Ward 1 and 4 seats in Ward 2, 3, 4.

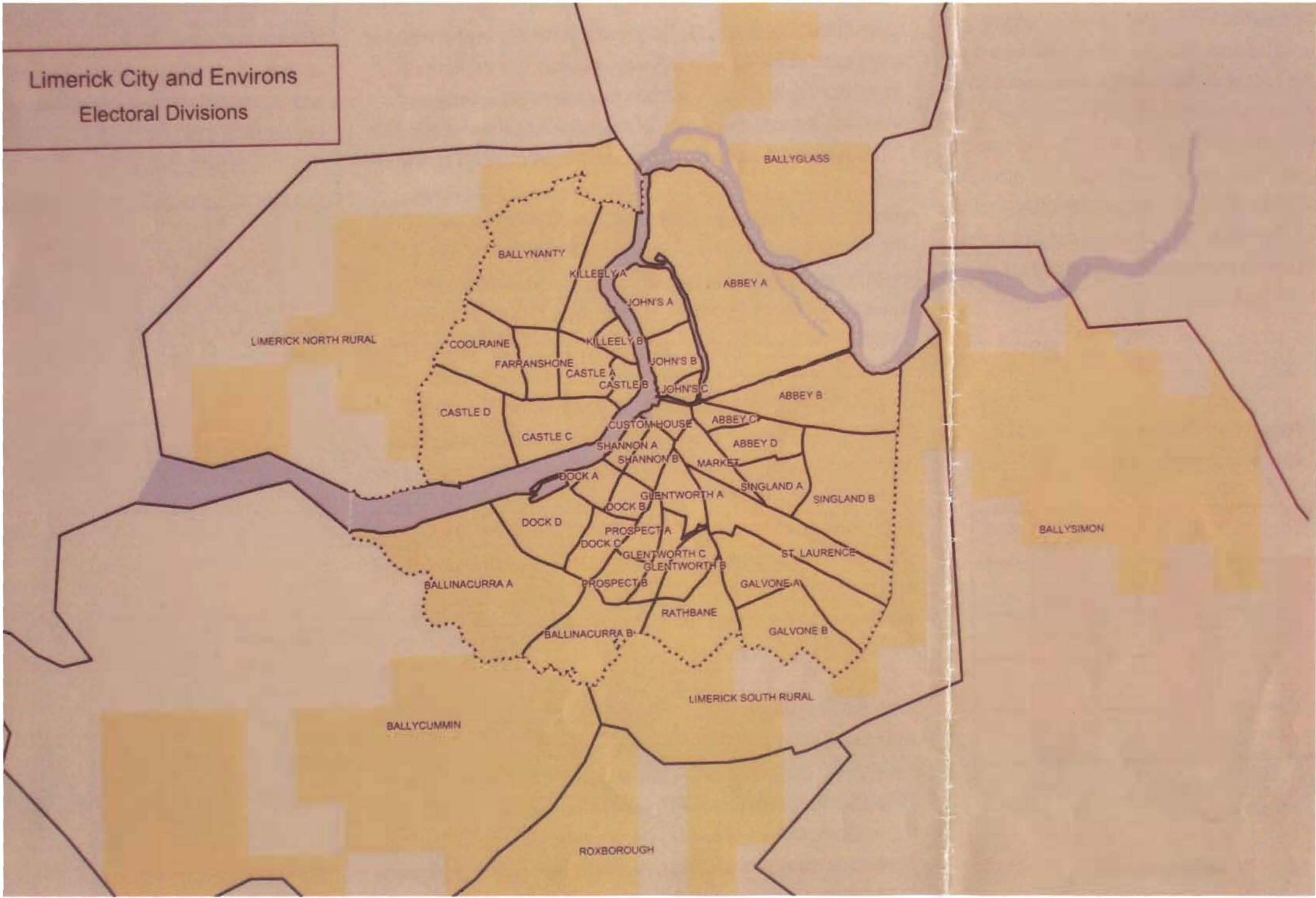

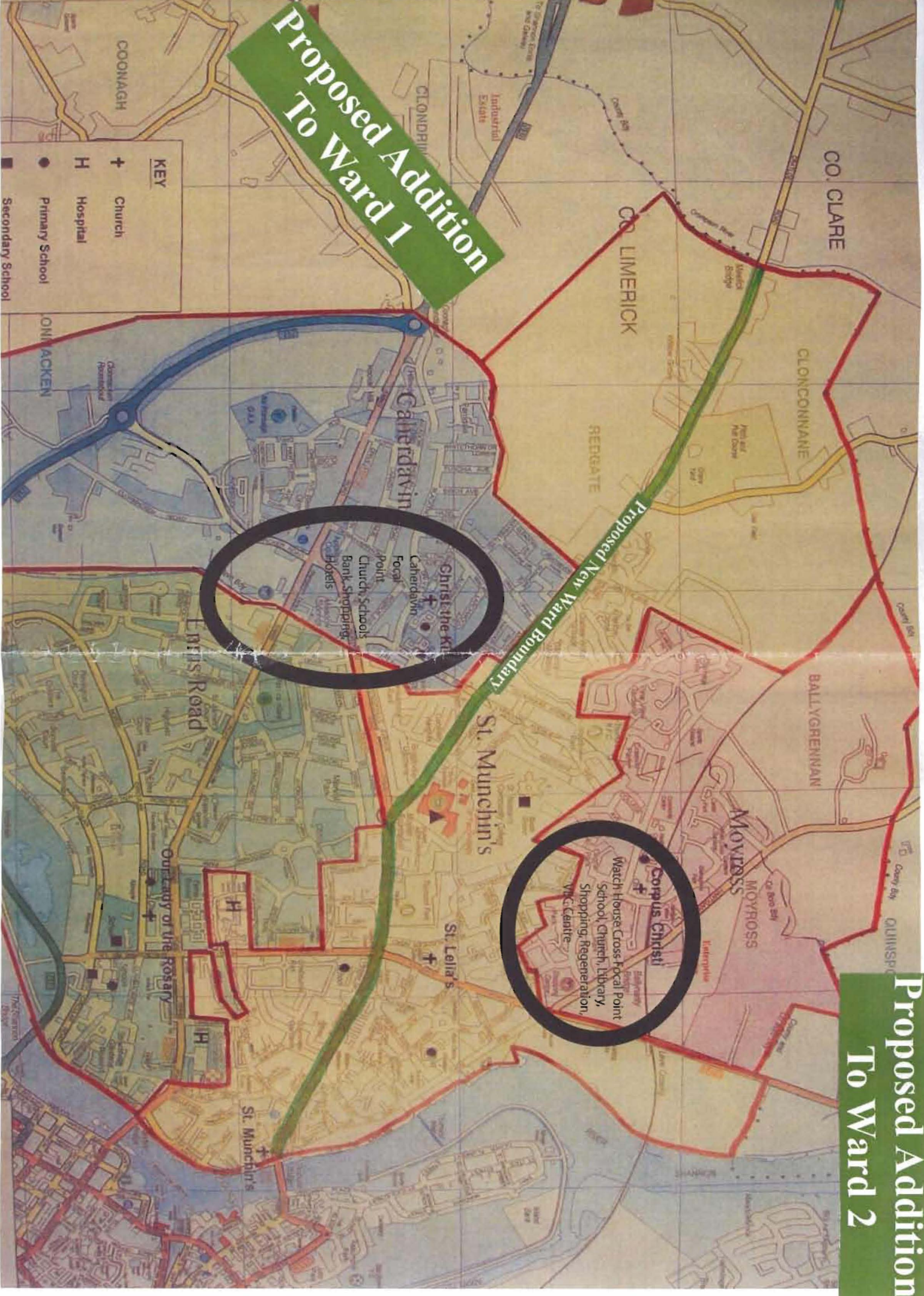
