
I wish to state that the Arva, Derrylane area is not adequately represented at local government level due to its geographical widespread structure. It is underpopulated for a five seater electoral area.

The bigger towns of Belturbet and Killeshandra take a lot of the attention of the public representatives. The village of Dowra and Blacklion are over 50 miles away from Arva. A four seater would suit the population better both numerically and geographically. This is the view of most of the people in the Arva area.

The Ballyjamesduff electoral area could be changed to a seven seater and this would provide ideal representation for this large region where there is a vast increase in the population of Mullagh and Virginia.

I suggest that Arva, Derrylane be included in the Ballyjamesduff electoral area.
