

To Secretary, Electoral Area Boundary Committee.

Submissions from Senator Dominic Hannigan.

1. The terms of reference of the committee should be altered to allow for an increase in representation for any local authority for which it is deemed necessary.
2. There should be an increase of two elected representatives each for Drogheda Borough Council, Dundalk Town Council and Bray Town Council because of the exceptionally high ratio of population to elected representatives in those towns compared to all other town councils.
3. There should be one extra representative each for the Slane and Dunshaughlin Electoral Areas of Meath County Council because of the large increase in population in these two areas.
