
On behalf of the Fianna Fáil members of Wexford County Council, we recommend that the minimum number of Electoral Area Boundaries in County Wexford be changed under this revision. We propose that:

- The Enniscorthy Electoral Area and Gorey Electoral Area boundaries should remain unchanged. Both were significantly altered under the last Boundary Revision in 1998.
- One seat be added to the Gorey Electoral Area, bringing the number of councillors representing the Area from four to five. The population of the Gorey Electoral Area has grown enough over the past 10 years to require five County Councillors.

- The Boundary between Wexford Electoral Area and New Ross Electoral Area be revised to bring a greater population into the New Ross Electoral Area from the Wexford Electoral Area, making the New Ross Area of sufficient population to retain five County Councillors.
- The number of County Councillors in the Wexford Electoral area be reduced by one, from seven to six, in order to facilitate the before mentioned changes.
