

**Submission to the Electoral Boundary Committee from the Sinn Fein members  
of Cavan Co. Council**

We would suggest that the existing Boundaries give a fair representation to the Electorate in Co. Cavan.

While the Belturbet Electoral Area may fall short of the numbers required we believe that because of the Geographical spread of the Area and the huge variance in population density the present representation of five elected members is essential to the requirements of the electorate.

We believe that Ballyconnell should be the recognised focal point of this area and any further extension into the Cavan Electoral Area would destabilise the existing structures.

We also recognise that the population increase in the Cavan, Ballyjamesduff and Baileboro Areas may show an imbalance in relation to the Belturbet Area, however because of the regional spread of the county the Belturbet Area should remain as it is at present.
