Dear Sir/ Madam,

I wish to make the following observation. I refer to two particular local electoral areas in Tipperary North, (1) Nenagh Newport and (2) Borrisokane electoral areas.

I wish to make the point that these two electoral areas have a very long and wide geographical area stretching from the limerick border in the south at Castleconnell and Murroe and northwards to the Galway and Offaly borders from portumna to Birr.

Over the last number of years the huge centres of population growth are Nenagh Town, Ballina and Newport, which need greater focus by relevant authorities and boundry commission.

Consideration should be given in making a three / four seater local electoral area stretching from Ballina ,Birdhill across towards Newport /Abington

and stretching northwards to Kilmore /Dolla

as they would include the two major and rapidly expanding towns of Newport and Ballina.

The recent and rapidly expanding of Ballina and Newport are closer and have a natural alignment towards Limerick City.
