Re: Electoral Area Boundary of Clontibret, Co. Monaghan

The Clontibret Development Association, wish to make a submission to the Electoral Area Boundary Committee, to review the local electoral area of Clontibret.

As a village, we are divided into two electoral areas, Mid-Monaghan and Monaghan Town. As such, we consider that if the area of Clontibret was in one electoral area only that we would have the possibility of having a local Clontibret representative on a council. We are also aware of a significant change in the population structure of both Clontibret and Annyalla in the past few years and that this would need to be addressed and taken into consideration in the drawing up of the electoral boundary.

We would be very concerned:

- (a) that the parish of Clontibret (including Annyalla and Doohamlet) would not be divided
- (b) and also that the village itself would not be divided.

Therefore we would make the suggestion that the whole of Clontibret Area would be amalgamated with the Mid-Monaghan Council.

We hope that you will consider this submission.
